



'I need my mom': Facing deportation, mother and sons seek refuge at Greensboro church

GREENSBORO - Facing deportation, another Triad woman who is living in the U.S. illegally has sought sanctuary at a Greensboro church, this time with her family.

Minerva Cisneros Garcia and two of her sons moved into Congregational United Church of Christ on Wednesday. She joins Juana Luz Tobar Ortega, a grandmother from Asheboro who sought refuge at St. Barnabas Episcopal Church a month ago.

This is the second known case in North Carolina and one of about 20 known cases across the country, according to a broad network of faith groups known as The Sanctuary Movement.
